Freedom of Choice is a necessity in blocking e-mail threats such as virus, spam, and harassing language.

CyberSoft International announced today that it has officially released SafeInternetEmail 3.0 (SIE) for ISPs, corporate, government, and academic customers.

SafeInternetEmail 3.0's user preferences are made possible with thirteen spam categories that may be selected by individual users to prevent respective spam from reaching their inbox. These categories utilize polymorphic macros written by CyberSoft International lexical analysts which significantly reduce the number of definitions required to effectively match spam. Bayes (statistical spam filtering) and virus detection may also be turned on or off by the individual user if allowed by company policy. SIE's user preferences are found in a clear interface that provides check box simplicity for user management.

SafeInternetEmail is an internet gateway software solution intended to supply the resources organizations require to help protect their users from inappropriate e-mail such as viruses, spam, harassment language, and malicious file types. CyberSoft International designed SafeInternetEmail to be a flexible solution to meet the demands of end-users and relieve the administrative hassles of conventional filtering solutions. Organizations using SafeInternetEmail can take control of their e-mail at the administrative level by delegating rights to the individual user. These end-user rights can be completely turned off or provided in three different levels to meet organizational policies concerning harassment language, blocked file types, spam, viruses, and custom created definitions. "SIE's SPAM tagging and per user preferences have allowed our customers to take back control of their mail boxes from SPAMers. The filter update service and statistical filtering catch more SPAM than any other filtering software we have tested. In addition, the built in virus scanning has completely eliminated help desk calls concerning messages with attached viruses," said Tyler Myers, Kwiknet.

SafeInternetEmail starts at \$895 for up to 100 users. Special ISP pricing and hosted solutions are also available. Both Enterprise and Service Provider versions of SIE are available through FSI.
